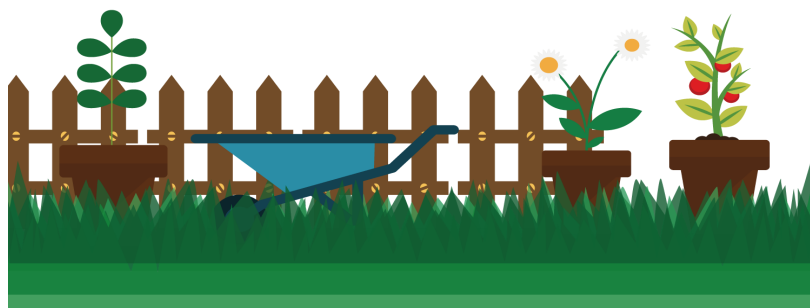



## INVITATION TO COMMUNION

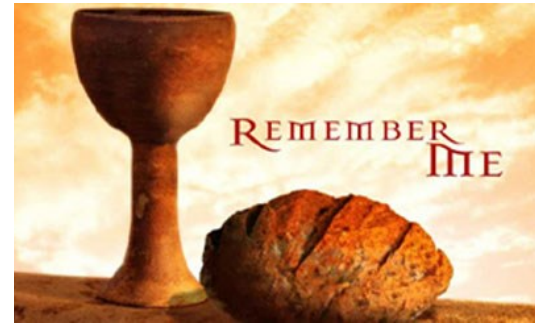
