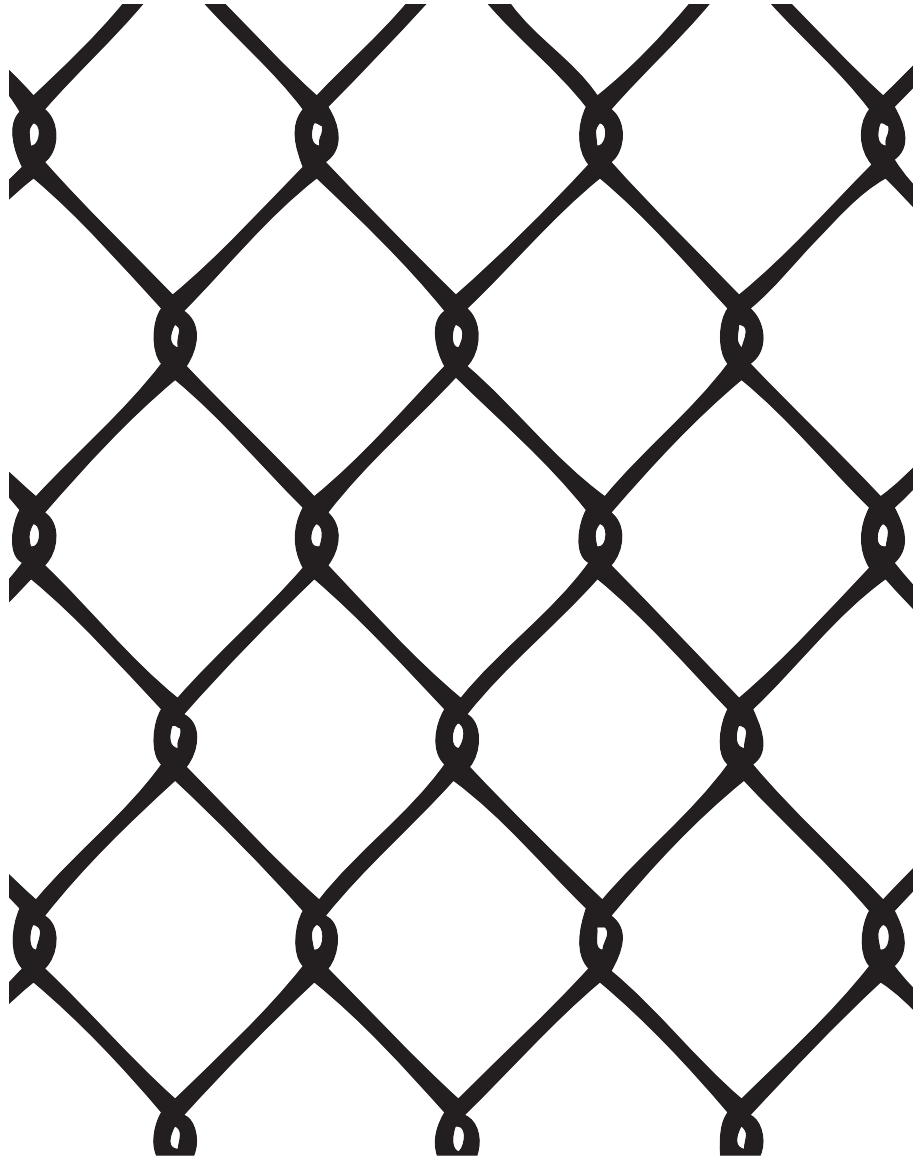


Prayer Stations

Epiphany 4

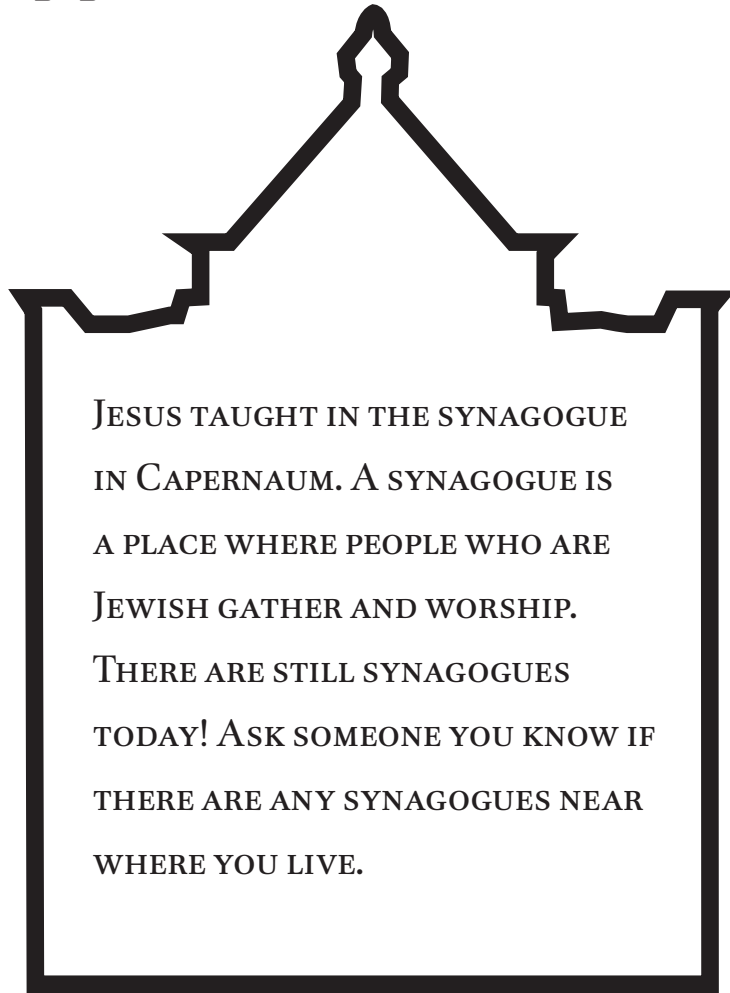
- Today is the **4th Sunday** in the season of Epiphany.
